Course Content:

The aim of this Scheme of Work is to encourage the young people at BCPRU to develop a better understanding of how they can develop and grow as individuals. This will be done by looking at topics based on personal and economic well-being and financial capability. It also aims to encourage pupils to think about the choices they have made in the past and the consequences of these choices. To encourage pupils to think about their future in a positive way and understand that they have the potential to make choices which will allow this.

The PSHCE curriculum at BCPRU has been designed to develop the skills needed to fulfil the aim, taking into consideration the mixed age range and mixed ability of each class. Units of work encourage class teaching to support varying learning styles.

During their placement pupils will have the opportunity to complete modules from the following lists:
